



GOD IS WORTHY OF OUR WORSHIP

In this lesson you will learn what true worship is and why God is worthy of our worship.

I. Definition of “worship”.

- A. “Worship” speaks of value, having earned, merited, having reached a place or point of being deserving of worship.
- B. Everyone is worshipping something, someone, some idea or concept.
- C. True worship is about giving your whole heart to God; it is about surrender; it is about recognizing that everything you have has come from God and everything you are is because of God.

II. What worship will be like in heaven – Revelation 4:1-11.

- A. Verse 4 – This verse describes the rapture of the Church.
- B. Verses 2-8 – Why we worship God and God alone.
 1. He is holy – He is without sin, pure, and completely separated from sin.
 2. He is almighty – all powerful.
 3. He is eternal – Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end.
- C. Verse 9 – Three things that we give God in our worship is glory, honor, and thanks.
- D. Verses 10-11 – We will cast our crowns before Him. Crowns are our accomplishments, achievements, and accumulations. These things should all be laid at His feet on a regular basis. Give God the glory for all the good things that have happened in your life.

III. He is worthy of our worship – Revelation 5:1-14.

- A. Verses 1-7 – The question in heaven was, “Who is worthy to open the scroll?”
- B. Verse 5 – The One worthy to open the scroll, “Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals.”
- C. Verse 9 – “You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood.”
- D. Verses 10-14 – “Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!” – v. 12.
- E. We are motivated to worship because God created us for a divine purpose and because Jesus was slain and redeemed us by His blood.

- When did you begin to understand the true meaning of “worship”?
- Was there a time you worshipped something, someone, some idea or concept?
- Are there accomplishments, achievements, and accumulations in your life that you need to lay at the feet of Jesus?

BE A DOER OF THE WORD

This week begin to evaluate your life in the area of worship. Begin to see every aspect of your life as a way to worship God. Move from the traditional mind-set of worship being a part of a church service to incorporating worship into your daily life. Also make this a week of casting your crowns at the feet of Jesus.
