

# Lifting Up the Name of Jesus

**(Believe on Jesus, Receive and Confess Him as Lord Today – You Shall Be Saved)**

## Isaiah 7:14 (NKJV)

Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name **Immanuel**.<sup>[1]</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Literally: *God-With-Us*

## Isaiah 9:6 (NKJV)

For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder.

**And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.**

## Matthew 1:22-23 (NKJV)

<sup>22</sup>So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: <sup>23</sup>"Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name **Immanuel**," which is translated, "God with us."

## John 1:29-30 (NKJV)

<sup>29</sup> The next day John saw **Jesus** coming toward him, and said, "**Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!**" <sup>30</sup>This is He of whom I said, "After me comes a Man who is preferred before me, for He was before me.

## Matthew 14:14 (NKJV)

And when **Jesus** went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and **healed their sick.**

## Matthew 27:50-54 (NKJV)

<sup>50</sup>And **Jesus cried out** again with a loud voice, and **yielded up His spirit.** <sup>51</sup>Then, behold, **the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom**; and the earth quaked, and the rocks were split, <sup>52</sup>and **the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised**; <sup>53</sup>and coming out of the graves after His resurrection, **they went into the holy city and appeared to many.** <sup>54</sup>So when the centurion and those with him, who were guarding Jesus, saw the earthquake and the things that had happened, they feared greatly, saying, "**Truly this was the Son of God!**"

## Mark 6:6-7 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup>But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek **Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He is risen! He is not here.** See the place where they laid Him. <sup>7</sup>But go, tell His disciples--and Peter--that He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him, as He said to you."

## Acts 2:36 (NKJV)

"Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that **God has made this Jesus**, whom you crucified, both **Lord and Christ.**"

## Hebrews 3:1-6 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider **the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus**, <sup>2</sup>who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house. <sup>3</sup>For this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house. <sup>4</sup>For every house is built by someone, but He who built all things is God. <sup>5</sup>And Moses indeed was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward, <sup>6</sup>but Christ as a Son over His own house, whose house we are if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end.

## John 20:30-31 (NKJV)

<sup>30</sup> And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; <sup>31</sup>but these are written that you may believe that **Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.**
