



## SERVANT LEADERSHIP (Part 4) YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE

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In this lesson you will learn how one person can make a difference, and ways to discover your place to serve.

### I. Review of previous lessons.

- A. Servant leadership – leaders who serve and servants who lead. Jesus is our example of a servant leader.
- B. Serve in four areas – in the home, work, school, and local church.
- C. God is building His Church, and we are one body with many members, each one equipped to do the work of the ministry (Ephesians 4:11-12).
- D. Your work or serving should be measurable, specific, and identifiable.
- E. Fulfillment comes when you find your place to serve.

### II. One man who made a difference in someone's life – Acts 9:10-19.

- A. The Lord told a man named Ananias to go to Saul of Tarsus and lay hands on him so that he might receive his sight.
- B. Ananias knew that Saul was a man who persecuted Christians, but he obeyed the Lord, went to Saul, and prayed for him. His sight was restored and he was filled with the Holy Spirit.
- C. Saul later became known as Paul who changed the world through his teaching and preaching and wrote more than half of the New Testament.

### III. Servant leader is another name for “volunteer”.

- A. Psalm 110:3 – “Your people shall be volunteers in the day of Your power.”
  1. People need to arise to fulfill the destiny, calling, and assignment that God has for them.

### IV. Several ways to the discovery of your place of serving.

- A. It may be what you do during the week in your workplace.
- B. It may be different from your work.
- C. Sometimes it is a process of discovering where you fit. Don't give up!
- D. Where you serve could be related to your own hurts and losses, and when you are healed you want to minister to others in these areas.
- E. God may lay on your heart to get involved with a social problem.
- F. You may serve through a hobby or side skill.
